

## Film permits versus life performance permits



| Permitted Activity            | Putting on a play in a park*  | Making a film in a park  |
|-------------------------------|---|--|
| Underlying permit philosophy  | consistency, standardization, and equitable access to PFR facilities & scarcity | collaboration, respect, working together to create a positive experience, requests               |
| Time required to issue permit | 6 weeks   | 2 business days;<br>4 days if request for road closures, multi-lane closures and special effects |
| Insurance required:           | yes   | yes  |
| Permit process                | See permit application  | Secure on-line application   |
| Permit fees                   | varies from \$74.38 to \$391.37   | Free   |

\* This is the same process if you wish to:
