Will Miller seek a court injunction?

Toronto Mayor David Miller is talking tough about the city workers strike, but waffled when asked if he would seek a court injunction to ease tensions at transfer stations.

Miller said he is disgusted by residents using the city as their own "personal dumping ground."

He addressed the media today at Metro Hall, and said the vast majority of Torontonians are proud of their city and wouldn't dump trash all over it.

"For those few individuals who don't get the message, illegal dumping will not be tolerated," he said.

He said he knows picketers are holding up people trying to dump their trash at transfer stations and added the city is pursuing "all measures" available to it to make sure the transfer stations are open.

When asked if those measures included a court injunction, Miller said: "I wouldn't include or exclude that" measure.
