Man arrested in arson investigation, Faces 15 charges, 14 Division

Between 9:50 p.m. on Monday, July 30, 2007, and 12:45 a.m. on Tuesday, July 31, 2007, it is alleged that the suspect caused fire damage to waste–disposal bins, and garages in the area near Queen Street West, between Strachan Avenue and Dunn Avenue.
