# **Program Purpose**

City Council sets corporate strategic direction, priorities and policies, authorizes the raising of revenue and approves the expenditure of funds for the provision of services in the municipality. The Council program provides the administrative and other resources required by Councillors to carry out their duties.

- Salaries and Fringe Benefits for Councillors and their support staff;
- Discretionary Office Expenses for each Councillor related to the operation of the Councillors' offices;
- General Council Expenses in the area of material & supplies, equipment and services.
