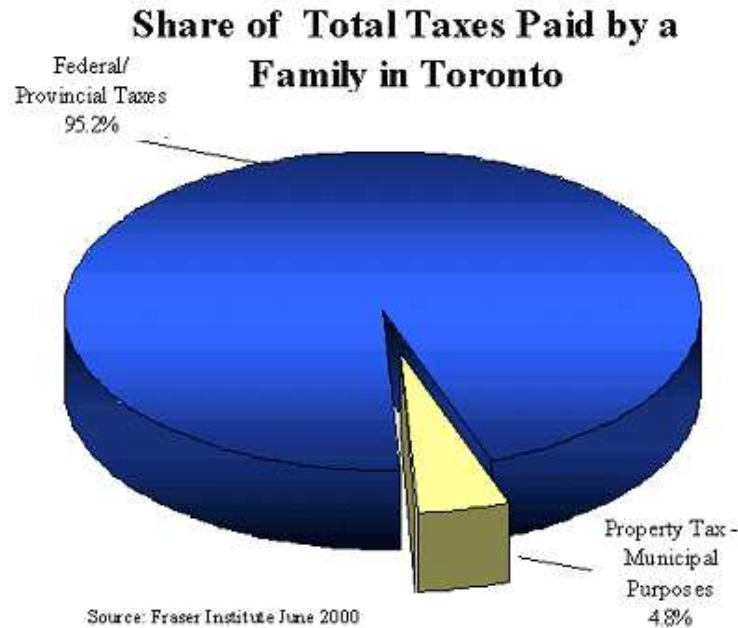

### Services Provided by the Municipal Tax Dollar

Municipal property taxes account for only 4.8 per cent of the total taxes (federal, provincial, municipal) paid by an average family in Toronto and Ontario. Below the chart is a list of services Toronto's citizens receive for that 4.8 per cent share.
